2 **Report from the Treasurer** (John Ellis)

Income and Expenditure accounts: UKWA deficit in 2007 of £18K compared to a surplus for 2006 of £10K - All income: memberships, event income, entries, freewave, racing (slalom + course racing), Fat Face and sponsorship decreased in 2007.

Also high expenditure on boats/equipment maintenance, purchase of Jet Ski and sound system (capital costs) and extra crew/fuel costs together with a deficit on Wave events not experienced in previous years.

Reserves: £28.7K at the end of 2006 now reduced to £9.9K at the end of 2007. This requires the Exec to prepare and stick to tight budgeting through 2008 to balance the books as another deficit of the magnitude of 2007 is not sustainable.
