

**Pre-Event information****Car & Trailer Parking:**

On arrival, campers can go directly to their booked space on the east side of the clubhouse. Launching can be from slipways 1 and 2. All other visitors should park in the main visitor car park on the right as you pass the barrier. Please park tidily as there will be many vehicles at the event. When this car park is full, the club car park officials will direct arrivals to alternative places on the site.



**Launching:**

As well as slipways 1 and 2, slipways 4,5,6,7 can be used. The current low water level means that we have a large 'beach' area between the slipways that can be used. The coxswains' slipway must not be used. This slipway and the jetties are for the sole use of RIBs and race management vessels.

**Safety & Security:**

Please do not walk through fenced off areas: they are fenced off for your safety.

Take particular care of the coxswains' slipway (East side of the Clubhouse in front of the coxswains' shed) as there are regular tractor movements on this slipway.

The fire exits from the Clubhouse are marked – the fire muster point is on the grass of the roundabout on the landside of the Clubhouse.

Please do not leave kit bags in the changing rooms, we cannot guarantee the safety of items left in there. Club members will also need space in which to change particularly on Sunday. There are lockers (green) in the café area which take a £1 coin

**Wash down:**

Boards must be washed down before leaving the Club to comply with non-native species guidance. Jet washes will be placed on shrimp alley, and a hose at the top of slipway 2.

**Dogs**

Dogs are welcome at the Club, but must be kept on a lead and under control at all times.

Please remember that there will be club activities during the weekend as well.
